

**The Governor James A. Rhodes Junior Fair
Endowment Fund Scholarship**

This scholarship is open to all junior fair exhibitors who will be incoming freshmen or undergraduate students at The Ohio State University College of Food, Agricultural and Environmental Sciences, or OSU-ATI, Wooster. You may apply for this scholarship as well as any one of the Ohio State Fair Scholarships.

OHIO STATE FAIR SCHOLARSHIPS

In an effort to recognize the quality youth of Ohio, and to help those interested in furthering their education, the Ohio Expositions Commission has established a Scholarship Program.

The purpose of these scholarships is to assist high school seniors (fall of 2009-2010) and graduates who are continuing their education at an accredited institution in an undergraduate course of study in any field.

Scholarships will be awarded to junior exhibitors during the Ohio State Fair. Applicants will be judged on Scholastic Standing, Citizenship and Leadership, Ohio State Fair Participation, County Fair Participation, and Financial Need.

RULES

1. The applicant must be a high school senior (fall of 2009-2010), or a graduate continuing their education at an accredited institution. They must reside in the State of Ohio, and must have been an active participant in the Ohio State Fair Junior Division and their local County Fair.
2. Applicant **MUST** be eligible to be a participant in Junior Fair (not older than 19 years as of January 1, 2010) and still be eligible to show at their County Fair and the Ohio State Fair.
3. All questions on the application form **MUST** be answered to be considered for an award. High school and/or college transcript **MUST** be attached, along with copies of ACT and/or SAT scores.
4. **Please mail completed applications to:** Scholarship Award Committee, Ohio State Fair, Agriculture Department, 717 East 17th Avenue, Columbus, Ohio 43211. Completed applications must be postmarked by **July 1, 2010**.
5. Applications will be judged on the following basis:

Scholastic Standing	25%
Citizenship & Leadership	25%
Ohio State Fair Participation	25%
County Fair Participation	20%
Financial Need	5%

*The Scholarship Committee reserves the right to **NOT** issue a scholarship if no applicant fulfills the requirements.

6. Applicants may be required to be interviewed at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.
7. Applicants may apply for only one (1) Ohio State Fair Scholarship Division.
8. Previous winners are not eligible to compete. An exhibitor may win a scholarship only one time.
9. Scholarship recipients will be **notified by August 1, 2010**. Scholarship will be awarded during the Sale of Champions at the Ohio State Fair, Sunday, August 8, 2010.
