

# OHIO STATE FAIR JUNIOR FAIR BOARD (JFB)

Youth organizations with representation on the JFB are actively involved with the annual Ohio State Fair. In most cases organizations will select members for a two-year term. Smaller organizations select one person every other year and large youth groups will select yearly to ensure continuity of operation. The JFB members serve as ambassadors for their youth organization, the Fair, and the public.

Responsibilities during the Fair include:

- Daily involvement with individual's organization
- Assist in the Celeste Center
- Various youth competitions
- Deliver and present awards
- Welcome fairgoers to various shows, stages, and events
- Other programs and activities as required
- Drive courtesy vehicles and pick up judges and officials
- Sale of Champions

- Livestock shows
